5 Reasons You Can't Wait – On your oral health

Regular dental care is critical to your overall health and well-being. Poor oral health goes beyond how your teeth look and feel – it can change what you eat, how much you enjoy your food and nutrition, and your self-esteem can take a hit too.





- Gum Disease It's sneaky. It may not be obvious until red, puffy gums appear along with bad breath, loose teeth, and even pain. All interfere with daily life. Prevent and intercept it with regular dental visits.
- 2. Oral Cancer That uncomfortable mouth sore may not go away on its own. Most do within 2 weeks, but if it doesn't, it could be something more serious. Let us check.
- Infection A painful infection can't wait for treatment and could spread to other parts of your body. We will help you heal.
- 4. Shifting Teeth Gum disease and other oral issues could encourage your teeth to shift, compromising your smile. Regular dental care helps find issues while they are still small – or prevent them all together!
